Jacqueline Janssen has consulted to businesses and nonprofit Boards, and she featured founders in her TV program, *Architects of Opportunities*.

She served on the Marin's Women's Commission as representative to the California Commission on Women, was a presenter at the UN Conference on Women, and was a Nominated Changemaker for President Obama's United States of Women. She is also an ongoing member of UN Women.

A former director on the NAMI Marin Board and the County Mental Health Board, Jacqueline is one of the creators of the Family Partnership Policy, advocating for families living with mental illness' participation in treatment and recovery.

Jacqueline Janssen's books include: *A Brief History of NAMI Marin*, *LeaveLight: Preparing for Vulnerable Family Members Left Behind After One's Death*, and *Siege of the Heptanese: Bare-boat Sailing in Greece*. She is currently completing *Every Homeless Person Has a Mother: How to Prevent Homelessness by Valuing Mothers' aka Women's Voices*.
